3. In the early years, what was your work position and major responsibilities?

At the age of 40 years in 1972, I was in my last year of college at Drake University. A woman of that age just graduating from college was unusual at that time. I was ready for my student teacher experience and had asked Drake to put me at the Women's Training Institute in Mitchellville. Drake did not have a contract with them for student teachers and was not willing to initiate one. My second request was to student teach at DMACC at the Ankeny campus so I could utilize my work experience in offices, of 20+ years. Again, there was no contract, but Drake did initiate a contract, and I became the first student teacher at Ankeny campus from Drake University. Because of my teaching experience, I was hired as a teacher in the Office Occupations Department as a legal secretary teacher. My previous work experience had been in a law office in Des Moines. Nineteen years later I retired from the department as chair.
