Bloomquist, that contracts be issued to personnel assigned to the Des Moines Skill Center for the period November 1, 1971 through June 30, 1972. RESOLUTION TO SELL HOUSE

A vote was taken and carried unanimously. Whereupon, the President of the Board declared said Resolution duly adopted as follows:

RESOLUTION APPROVING SALE OF HOUSE

RESOLVED, that the following described real estate situated in the City of Ankeny, Polk County, State of Iowa, to-wit:

Spahr Manor, Plat No. 8, located in the SE½ of the SW½ of Section 24, Township 80 North, Range 24, West of the 5th P.M., Iowa (513 East 11th Street)

heretofore purchased by said Des Moines Area Community College for the purpose of providing a site for the construction project for the Building Trades class under the direction of said Des Moines Area Community College and with a view toward resale upon completion of said construction project, at which time said real estate became surplus, and duly advertised for sale pursuant to the provisions of Iowa Code Section 297.23, is hereby declared to be surplus property, having no further school purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that said real estate shall be sold to Lawrence E. and Vivian J. MacDonald, Ankeny, Iowa, who submitted the high bid in response to said auction, for the consideration of \$34,000.00, the same representing said high bid and being equal to the fair market value of said real estate. It is the opinion of said Board that such sale is in the best interest of and for the benefit of said Des Moines Area Community College.

NOW THEREFORE, the President and Secretary of this Community College are hereby authorized, directed, and empowered to execute and deliver a warranty deed conveying said premises to the said Lawrence and Vivian J. MacDonald as joint tenants, upon receipt of said consideration.
