Topics discussed were:


- a. Funding formula changes currently being finalized by the IACCP/IACCT, and

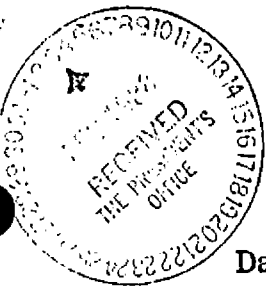

CONFIDENTIAL COMMUNITY COLLEGE TUITION SURVEY  
FOR 1988-89

Data collected January 28, 1988

- Area I            Currently \$300 per quarter for 12 hours and over. \$25.00 per credit. No increase anticipated.
- Area II          Currently \$510 per semester for 12 hours and over. \$42.50 per credit. No decision on an increase, if there is an increase it would be 2-3%.
- Area III        Currently \$315 per quarter for 12 hours and over. \$30.00 per credit. Any anticipated increase is unknown at this time.
- Area IV         Current \$280 per quarter for 12 hours and over. \$23.00 per credit. 7% increase to \$300.
- Area V          Currently \$500 per semester for 12 hours and over. \$41.75 per credit. Unknown if there will be an increase.
- Area VI         Currently \$475 per semester for 12 hours and over. \$40.00 per credit. Considering from 0-35% increase. Most likely 10%.
- Area VII        Currently \$312 per quarter for 15 hours and over. \$26.00 per credit. Not discussing any increase.
- Area IX         Currently \$470 per semester for 12 hours and over. \$43.00 per credit. No discussions by the board.
- Area X          Discussing going from quarter system to semester system. Currently \$276 for 12 hours and over. \$23.00 per credit. May go to \$525 per semester for 15 hours and over. \$35.00 per credit.
- Area XI         Currently \$29.50 per credit. Semester basis. Straight credit hour charge. No increase is being discussed.
- Area XII        Currently \$270 per quarter for 12 hours and over. \$23.00 per credit. Going to \$300.
- Area XIII       Going from quarter system to semester system. Currently \$340 per quarter for 12 hours and over. \$32.00 per credit. Will be \$675 per semester for 15 hours and over.
- Area XIV        Currently \$31.50 per credit. Quarter calendar/semester hours. Straight credit hour charge. No increase.
- Area XV         Currently \$30.00 per credit. Quarter calendar/semester hours. Straight credit hour charge. No increase.
- Area XVI        Currently \$502 per semester for 15 hours and over. \$34.50 per credit. Board has not discussed any increase.
